

Allogeneic Transplant Timeline

1 Initial BMT Visit

- Meet physician, transplant coordinator, social worker, and physical therapist
- Begin caregiver and lodging plan
- HLA typing and donor search started

2 Insurance Authorization

- Get testing required by insurance (i.e., PFT, echo, EKG, chest x-ray, labs, etc.)
- Work on dental clearance

3 Education Class

- Attend education class with your caregiver to learn about the transplant process
- Prepare your home

5 Consent and Central Line

- Review workup testing with physician and sign transplant consent forms
- Have central line placed

4 Workup Testing

- Before transplant, undergo necessary testing (i.e., imaging, echo, PFT, EKG, bone marrow biopsy, labs, specialty consults, etc.)
- Donor workup and clearance is performed

7 Post-Transplant

- Return home or to temporary housing within 40 miles or 60 minutes of the hospital for ~+100 days post-transplant
- Attend all follow-up appointments at the hospital then transition to long-term follow-up care

6 Stem Cell Transplant

- Be admitted to hospital for ~ 4 weeks
- Begin conditioning regimen (chemotherapy and possibly radiation)
- Get donor stem cell infusion via your central line (Day 0)
