

Autologous Transplant Timeline

1

Initial BMT Visit

- Meet physician, transplant coordinator, social worker, and physical therapist
- Start chemotherapy and/or radiation with hematologist
- Begin caregiver and lodging plan

4

Collection Consent

- Review testing with physician and sign collection consent forms

2

Collection and Insurance Authorization Testing

- Get testing required by insurance and the BMT program (i.e., bone marrow biopsy, PET scan, PFT, echo, EKG, chest x-ray, labs, etc.)
- Work on dental clearance

Education Class

- Attend education class with your caregiver to learn about the transplant process
- Prepare your home

Pre-Transplant Workup Testing

- Before transplant, undergo necessary repeat testing (i.e., bone marrow biopsy, PET scan, echo, PFT, EKG, labs, specialty consults, etc.)
- Have central line placed if applicable

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Transplant Consent

- Review workup testing with physician and sign transplant consent forms

Collection

- Have central line placed
- Begin stem cell mobilization and Collection ~6-16 days
- Begin chemotherapy, if needed

Post-Transplant

- Return home or to temporary housing within 40 miles or 60 minutes of the hospital for ~+30 days post-transplant
- Attend all follow-up appointments at the hospital then transition to-term follow-up care

Stem Cell Transplant

- Be admitted to hospital for ~2 weeks, if applicable
- Begin conditioning regimen (chemotherapy)
- Get infusion of stem cells via your central line (Day 0)
