

# CAR T-Cell Therapy Timeline

## 1 Initial BMT Visit

- Meet physician, transplant coordinator, social worker, and physical therapist
- Start/continue chemotherapy and/or radiation with hematologist if indicated
- Begin caregiver and lodging plan

## 2 Pre-Leukapheresis and Insurance Authorization Testing

- Get testing required by insurance and the CAR T program (i.e., bone marrow biopsy, PET scan, PFT, echo, EKG, chest x-ray, labs, etc.)
- Work on dental clearance

## 4 Leukapheresis Consent

- Review testing with physician and sign Leukapheresis consent forms

## 3 Education Classes

- Attend education class with your caregiver to learn about the CAR T process
- Prepare your home

## 6 Pre-Lymphodepletion Workup Testing

- Before lymphodepletion chemotherapy/CAR T-cell infusion, undergo necessary repeat testing (i.e., bone marrow biopsy, PET scan, echo, PFT, EKG, labs, specialty consults, etc.)

## 7 Lymphodepletion Consent

- Review workup testing with physician and sign lymphodepletion consent forms

## 9 Post-Infusion

- Return home or to temporary housing within 40 miles or 60 minutes of the hospital for ~+30 days post-cell infusion
- Attend all follow-up appointments at the hospital then transition to-term follow-up care

## 8 CAR T-Cell Infusion

- Have central line placed
- Begin lymphodepleting chemotherapy
- Get infusion of CAR T-cells via your central line (Day 0)
- Admit to the hospital same day or plan to remain outpatient (product/patient dependent)

## 5 Leukapheresis

- Have temporary line placed
- 1 day collection of T-cells
- Temporary line removed after leukapheresis
- Resume chemotherapy, if needed
